Bonney Lake, WA. 98391 Attn: Phil Herrera, Project Manager. EPFR will evaluate the information on file and interview one or more firms regarding a possible contract for professional services. Specifically, the District is soliciting proposals for the following specific discipline:

Special Inspection & Testing, for soils compaction, concrete compressive strength, fasteners, welding, sealants/coatings. Other construction related inspection & additional required testing as needed.

EPFR is commencing construction of a new 17,000 sq.ft. fire station in Edgewood, WA. This is the first of multiple fire station build projects within the district over the next two to three years.

The attached file contains the special inspections plan sheet set should be used as reference of required special inspection scope and capability.

The District will contract with the most highly qualified firm, or firms, under the criteria established by the District, which include but are not limited to: level of experience and responsibility, references from past municipal or private clients of the firm, familiarity with development of public and private projects in Pierce County, past dealings with Pierce County Planning and Land Services and experience with county regulations related to site development, wetlands, and development engineering.
