The following services are examples of the work that the owner will need provided. Project trip generations, Project trip distribution and assignment, preparation of scoping letters for submittal to the local jurisdiction of authority.

TIA elements to include, Existing roadway network conditions, Existing traffic volumes, Existing traffic operations, Traffic safety analysis, Non-motorized facilities, Planned future improvements, Future traffic volumes, Site access analysis, mitigation measures, and Documentation of analysis and findings.
