BE READY

LEVEL 1:

A Level 1 Evacuation means <u>BE READY</u> for potential evacuation. There is fire in your local area.

Make preparations for family with special needs, mobile property, and pets or livestock.

Monitor local social media, television news and radio sources for updated information.

Public safety personnel may contact you via an emergency notification system.

GET SET

LEVEL 2:

A Level 2 Evacuation means GET SET to evacuate. Be prepared to leave at a moment's notice.

Relocate to a specified shelter (if activated) or with family/ friends outside the affected area.

Residents MAY have time to gather necessary items, but doing so increases risk.

THIS MAY BE THE ONLY NOTICE GIVEN.

LEVEL 3:

A Level 3 Evacuation means <u>GO</u>.
Evacuate NOW.

Leave immediately.

Danger in your area is current or imminent.

DO NOT delay leaving to gather any belongings or make efforts to protect your home.

THIS WILL BE THE LAST NOTICE GIVEN.
